What is Mondial.Tech Startups Awards?

MONDIAL.TECH Startup Awards is the biggest competition between startups from the entire world and it is dedicated to the automobile and future mobility industries. It is an international event that supports innovation and gives startups the opportunity to showcase their latest designs and tech, to meet strategic partners, and to shape the future of Autotech.

- Finalists will get a free exhibition space during Mondial.Tech to present their product

Application and selection process

Who can apply?

The MONDIAL.TECH Startup Awards is open to startups, small enterprises & internal ventures dedicated to the Automotive industry, working in the following fields: Sustainable Mobility, Electrification & hybridization, Material & weight reduction, Comfort & well-being experience, Storage & energetic systems, Connectivity & ITS, Safety, Automatization & Cybersecurity, Industry 4.0.

What is the deadline for submitting applications?

Startups can apply online until June 17th

Application and selection process

What is the competition process?

Startups can apply in one of the following categories:

Sustainable Mobility, Electrification & hybridization, Material & weight reduction, Comfort & well-being experience, Storage & energetic systems, Connectivity & ITS, Safety, Automatization & Cybersecurity, Industry 4.0.

After receiving applications, 64 startups will be selected in Mid-July (8 per category).

During MONDIAL.TECH, these finalists will get a free exhibition space where meetings with potential clients (car manufacturers, OEMS, etc.) will be organized. They will also have the opportunity to pitch in front of an international jury of investors, experts and industry professionals at Mondial.Tech.

Application and selection process

Each of the 8 categories will have a sponsor who will publicly commit to exploring a collaboration with the winner.

On Friday October 6th, the overall winner will be announced, among the 8 winners of the categories

Can I compete in more than one category?

Startups can apply in different categories, but if selected you will be featured in one category (to be decided by organizers).

Is it possible to change my application once submitted?

It is possible to change your application before the deadline and you need to contact the organizers by email (info@mondial.tech) or by F6S (<https://www.f6s.com/mondialtech/discuss>).

Application and selection process

How much is the entry fee?

Applying to the MONDIAL.TECH Startup Awards is free of charge. If selected, the startups will get complimentary registrations.

What other key dates should I keep in mind?

Mondial TECH will take place on Oct 2nd to 6th at Paris Expo Porte de Versailles Convention Center.

Pitching sessions

How is the pitching process?

The pitching sessions take place at Mondial Tech. The pitches are in English and only one representative from the startup will be able to pitch on stage.

The 8 finalists per category will pitch in front of the audience and a jury conformed by international leaders. [\(See the complete list here\)](#)

The pitch is followed by Q&A between the finalist and the jury members.

Finalists will receive detailed information about the pitching session.

Will there be winners in the competition?

The jury will select one winner in each category.

Pitching sessions

Who are the jury members?

The jury is composed by leaders in the Autotech industry from international companies such as: Renault, Peugeot Citroën, Robert Bosch Ventures, Faurecia, Atomico, German AutoLabs, among others.

What is the winning prize?

Sponsors are committed to exploring a collaboration with the winning startup (incubation, acceleration or deployment).
